Deeds since 1690 & Memorial of an undated Deed of Settlement  
made the twelve first day of June one thousand eight hundred and  
Twenty four wherein John Shee Lawlor of Killarney in the County of  
Kerry Esq of the said first Daniel Malony of Dunloe Castle near  
Killarney in said County Esq of the second part and Margaret Shee  
Lawlor otherwise Malony the wife of said John Shee Lawlor and the  
youngest Daughter of the said Daniel Malony of the third part Reciting  
as follows is Recited he the said Daniel Malony for and in Consideration  
of Marriage made since January between the said John Shee  
Lawlor and the said Margaret Shee Lawlor owing Malony and for  
other Considerations thereon mentioned with the Consent of the said  
Margaret Shee Lawlor owing Malony testified by her being an  
executing party thereto granted bargained assigned transferred and  
made over unto the said John Shee Lawlor his executors administrators and  
assigns a sum of Five hundred pounds being the one fourth part or  
proportion of a sum of two thousand pounds to which the said  
Margaret Shee Lawlor owing Malony became entitled as one of the  
said younger Children of the said Daniel Malony and eighth Malony  
owing Cregg his wife under and by virtue of the Settlement Recited  
in the instrument of the said Daniel Malony unto the said Eighth  
Malony thereto Recited and Charged and Charged in the Castle  
Dowry and lands of Dunlough otherwise Dunloe heretofore in  
the possession of Peter Dunnes Esq and that part of Dunloe Estate  
Called the Gleens Coonagoura Curraghmore and Cappaghree the lands  
of Killagh Mervafone in proportion of Thence Cregg Malony and his  
tenants and representatives that part of the lands of Coolmagort  
containing Ninty Acres or thereabouts there or theretofore in the  
possession of Gustavus Adolphus Prior Prester Crosbie his tenants and

granted Charged assigned transferred and made over unto the said  
Margaret Shee Lawlor owing Malony and his assigns an Annuity  
or yearly Rent charge of One hundred and fifty pounds Sterling  
paid Decrees Charged upon and to be paid and payable out of  
all that and those the Town and lands of Ballincallan Barranagh  
Glengiffey Killinagh Cobally and Knockkeer Situate in the  
Barony of Magony and County of Kerry the Town and lands of  
Portleven Situate in the Barony of Beara and County of Cork  
the lands of Shanaklow and Ballyleam Situate in the Barony of  
Dunquin and County of Kerry the upperside moiety of the Tithes  
both great and small of the parishes of Mallahiff Kilchecrone and  
Killorane together with the tithes to the said parishes of Mallahiff  
belonging Situate in the County of Kerry aforesaid the upperside  
Tithes both great and small of the other Town and lands of  
Kinscragh and Hermangagh Situate in the Barony of Magony parish  
of Kilcoleman and County of Kerry aforesaid a garden formerly known by  
the name of Newgarden at the end of the New Street in the Town of
