

To The Registrar appointed by Act of Parliament for Registering Deeds and Bonds & other matters of an intended Deed of Settlement made the twenty first day of June one thousand eight hundred and twenty four between John Shea Lawlor of Dublin in the County of Kerry Esq of the first part Daniel Mahony of Dublin Castle near Killybeg in said County Esq of the second part and Margaret Shea Lawlor otherwise Mahony the wife of said John Shea Lawlor and the youngest Daughter of the said Daniel Mahony of the third part Reading as therein is recited he the said Daniel Mahony for and in Consideration of all Marriage Ties and Affinities between the said John Shea Lawlor and the said Margaret Shea Lawlor otherwise Mahony and for other Considerations therein mentioned with the Consent of the said Margaret Shea Lawlor otherwise Mahony testified by her being an Executing party thereto granted bargained assigned transferred and made over unto the said John Shea Lawlor his Executors and assigns a Sum of Five hundred pounds being the one fourth part or proportion of a Sum of Two thousand pounds to which the said Margaret Shea Lawlor otherwise Mahony became entitled as one of the said younger Children of the said Daniel Mahony and Elizabeth Mahony otherwise Mahony his wife under and by Virtue of the Settlement executed on the intermarriage of the said Daniel Mahony with the said Elizabeth Mahony recited and charged and chargeable on the Castle Docks and lands of Duntough otherwise Duntloo theretofore in the possession of Peter Dumas Esq and that part of Duntloo Estate called the Glens Corragh Curraghmore and Cappaghroe the lands of Clodagh theretofore in the possession of Pierce Curagh O'Malley and his tenants and Representatives that part of the lands of Coolinagort containing Ninety Acres or thereabouts then or theretofore in the possession of Gustavus Adolphus Esq or Thacker Crosbie his tenants and Representatives that part of the lands of Coolinagort aforesaid containing Sixty five Acres or thereabouts then or theretofore in the possession of Thomas Blumehurst Esq of Peters his tenants or Representatives and yearly fee farms Rent or Sums of twenty eight

Pounds twelve Shilling by the year issuing and payable out of that part of the lands of Coolinagort aforesaid known by the name of Beaufort with the estate thereto belonging theretofore in the possession of Charles Crosbie his tenants or assigns the town and lands of Upper Duntloo Smacon and Cappaghroe also situate in the Barony of Dunherwin and County of Kerry aforesaid the lands of Glencullen Broughy Scrahanseagh Knockree or that part thereof called Lower Knockree a tenement in the Town of Killybeg aforesaid in which John Mahony father of the said Daniel Mahony then lived and apart of a tenement called Andrew Moores tenement situate in the said Town the Town and lands of Killybeg Knockree the two plow lands of Derrymadee and East Dromad and of the upper part of Coolinagort formerly belonging to the Earl of Shelburne the said lands and premises situate in the County of Kerry the said Sum of Five hundred pounds and the interest to grow due thereon unto the said John Shea Lawlor his Executors and assigns as his and their proper goods and Chattels for ever and for the Consideration aforesaid and therein he the said Daniel Mahony granted bargained assigned transferred conveyed and made over unto the said John Shea Lawlor his Executors and assigns one fourth part or proportion of such Sums or Sums of Money as he the said Daniel Mahony his Executors and assigns or any person in trust for him or them was then or should hereafter become entitled to under and by Virtue of the Will of Lieutenant Colonel Denis Mahony therein recited such one fourth part or Share to amount to One thousand pounds at least to hold and take the same after the death of Leonard Mahony Esquire to the said John Shea Lawlor his Executors and assigns as his and their own proper goods and Chattels for ever and by said Deed now recited he the said John Shea Lawlor for the Consideration therein and for the purpose of making provision for the said Margaret Shea Lawlor otherwise Mahony in Case she should survive him granted charged assigned transferred and made over unto the said Margaret Shea Lawlor otherwise Mahony and her assigns one Annuity or yearly Rent charge of One hundred and fifty pounds Sterling yearly to be paid quarterly upon and to be issuing and payable out of all that and those the Town and lands of Boolewallane Scrahanseagh Glencullen Killybeg Cobally and Knockree situate in the Barony of Magersbeg and County of Kerry the Town and lands of Gorteenore situate in the Barony of West Bransby and County of Kerry the lands of Shanacloon and Killybeg situate in the Barony of Dunherwin and County of Kerry the impropriate rectory of the Parishes both great and small of the parishes of Malahiff Killynecane and Killynecane together with the glebe to the said parishes of Malahiff Killynecane both great and small of the said Town and lands of Knockree and Scrahanseagh situate in the Barony of Magersbeg parish of Killynecane and County of Kerry aforesaid a garden formerly known by the name of Newgard at the end of the New Street in the Town of Killybeg aforesaid was called Doctor Lawlor's House and the said Annuity of one hundred and fifty pounds to be in full for the lifetime of said Margaret Shea Lawlor otherwise Mahony payable as therein with a power of discharge for the recovery thereof and which said Deed and
